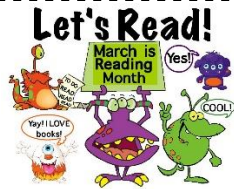

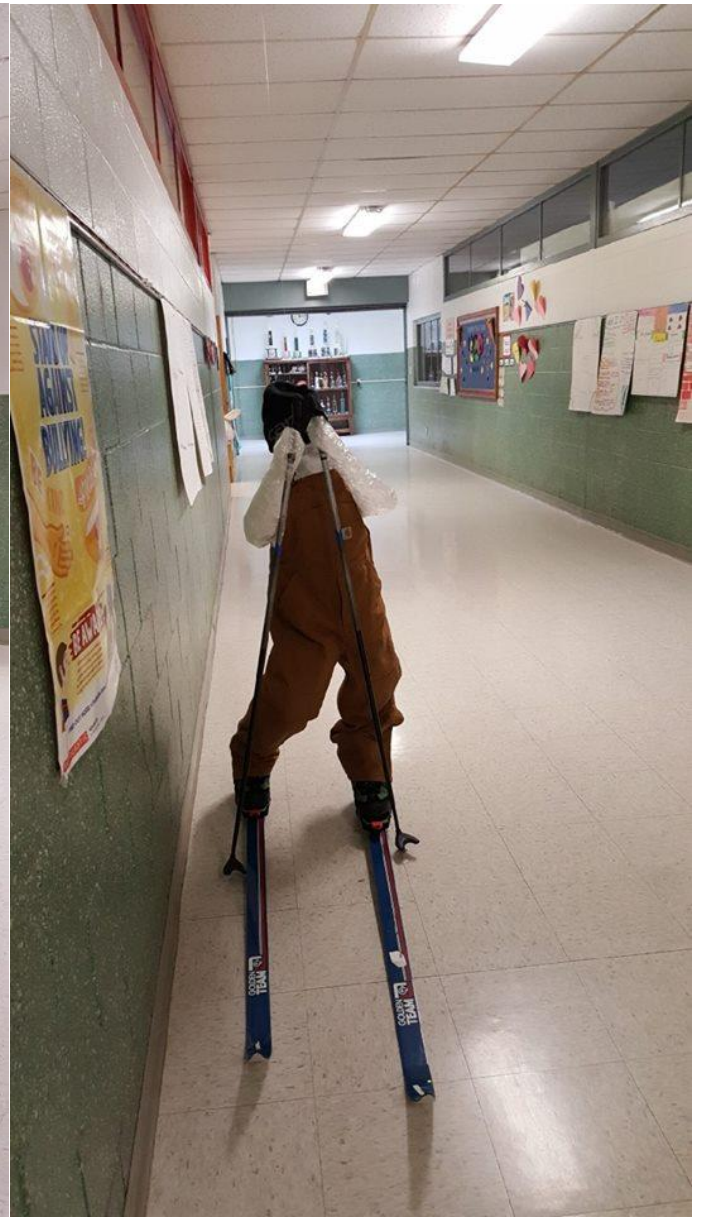


GREAT NEWS!!
